BirdLife Tasmania is hosting the 2018 Australasian Shorebird Conference at the Life Sciences Lecture Theatre 1, University of Tasmania, Sandy Bay Campus, on the weekend of 27 and 28 October 2018. Two days of oral presentations on research, conservation and management efforts on resident and migratory shorebirds will be given on the Conference theme, "Losing their habitats – conservation and management strategies for migratory and resident shorebirds".

If you wish to present an oral or poster at the ASC, please email the convenor as soon as possible. The Conference will provide a forum for discussions on all shorebird species, and is particularly keen to see contributions from students, indigenous researchers and land managers.

In conjunction with the ASC, The Overwintering Project (https://www.theoverwinteringproject.com/) will be holding an exhibition of shorebird art at the Moonah from October 18 - November 10, with the exhibition's Official Opening to be held on Friday 26 October.

Two pre- and post-conference birding trips (subject to interest) to see shorebirds and woodland and endemic birds in southeast Tasmania are being offered. Please bring your binoculars for either excursion.

<u>Excursion 1</u>: Shorebirds, PittWater Orielton and Lauderdale: Friday 26 October 2018, \$150 per person, places limited to 23 persons.

The excursion will commence at 9:00am in the city centre (exact site to be confirmed) and return to the city at 4:15pm. The Conference Icebreaker commences at 6:00pm) at the Moonah Arts Centre, 23-27 Albert Road, Moonah (approximately 10 minutes by taxi from the city centre).

The excursion will visit the Pitt Water Orielton Lagoon Ramsar wetlands (http://www.environment.gov.au/cgi-bin/wetlands/ramsardetails.pl?refcode=6), approximately 30 minutes east of Hobart. The site is within the South Arm IBA (http://birdlife.org.au/documents/KBA-2page-100km City Guide-Hobart.pdf)

<u>Excursion 2</u>: Woodland and endemic birds, Bruny Island: Monday 29 October 2018, \$165 per person, places limited to 23 persons.

The excursion will commence at 8:30am in the city centre (exact site to be confirmed) and return to city at 4:00pm. The excursion will visit a range of sites on Bruny Island to see Tasmanian endemic species – it is possible to see all 12 species in a day on Bruny Island. The entire island comprises the Bruny Island IBA (http://birdlife.org.au/documents/KBA-2page-100km_City_Guide-Hobart.pdf)

Excursion costs are all inclusive: bus and ferry fare (Bruny Island excursion only), packed lunch and driver/guide and tour leader. Telescopes will be provided for the shorebird excursion.

As places are limited for both, participation in excursions will only be confirmed on full payment.

The weekend preceding the ASC sees the holding of the 4th Bruny Island Bird Festival (see details at http://www.brunybirdfestival.org.au/) on Bruny Island. 






